Today !!!

Luke 24:1-35

Now on the first *day* of the week, (Sunday) very early in the morning, they, and certain *other women* with them, came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. :2 But they found the stone rolled away from the tomb. :3 Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. :4 And it happened, as they were greatly perplexed about this, that behold, two men stood by them in shining garments. :5 Then, as they were afraid and bowed *their* faces to the earth, they said to them, “Why do you seek the living among the dead? :6 He is not here, but is risen! Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee, :7 saying, “The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.’”:8 then they remembered His words. :9 Then they returned from the tomb and told all these things to the eleven and to all the rest. :10 It was Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary *the mother* of James, and the other *women* with them, who told these things to the apostles. :11 **And their words seemed to them like idle tales, and they did not believe them.** :12 But Peter arose and ran to the tomb; and stooping down, he saw the linen cloths lying by themselves; and he departed, **marveling to himself at what had happened.** :13 Now behold, two of them were traveling that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was seven miles from Jerusalem. :14 And they talked together of all these things which had happened. :15 So it was, while they conversed and reasoned, that Jesus Himself drew near and went with them. :16 But their eyes were restrained, so that they did not recognize Him. :17 And He said to them, “**What kind of conversation is this that you have with one another as you walk and are sad?**” :18 Then the one whose name was Cleopas answered and said to Him, “Are You the only stranger in Jerusalem, and have You not known the things which happened there in these days?” :19 And He said to them, “**What things?**” So they said to Him, “The things concerning Jesus of Nazareth, who was a Prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, :20 and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to be condemned to death, and crucified Him. :21 But we were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem Israel. Indeed, besides all this, today is the third day since these things happened. :22 Yes, and certain women of our company, who arrived at the tomb early, astonished us. :23 When they did not find His body, they came saying that they had also seen a vision of angels who said He was alive. :24 And certain of those *who were* with us went to the tomb and found *it* just as the women had said; but Him they did not see.” :25 Then He said to them, “**O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! :26 Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?**” :27 **And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.** :28 Then they drew near to the village where they were going, and He indicated that He would have gone farther. :29 But they constrained Him, saying, “Abide with us, for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent.” And He went in to stay with them. :30 Now it came to pass, as He sat at the table with them, that He took bread, blessed and broke *it*, and gave it to them. :31 Then their eyes were opened and they recognized Him; and He suddenly vanished from their sight. :32 And they said to one another, “Did not our heart burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?” :33 So they rose up that very hour and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven and those *who were* with them gathered together, :34 saying, “The Lord is risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!” :35 And they told about the things *that had happened*...

THE ONE AND ONLY SAVOIR OF MANKIND

1.) It's only Jesus - who *has* you on His *mind*

No one in life and death cares for you like Jesus

Because that's true - the Bible says...

Gal. 3:22

But the Scripture has confined all under sin, that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe.

Heb. 12:2

looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of *our* faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

2.) It's only Jesus - who *is* *inviting* you to His house

His invitation will not be cancelled or changed or lost

Because that's true - the Bible says...

John 14:1-3

“Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. :2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if *it were* not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. :3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also.

Psa. 27:4

One *thing* I have desired of the LORD, That will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the LORD All the days of my life,

3.) It's only Jesus - who *will guarantee your life*

Your life has a warranty - but you've gotta return it !!!

Because that's true - the Bible says...

John 14:18

I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you. **:19** "A little while longer and the world will see Me no more, but you will see Me. Because I live, you will live also.

John 6:33

For the bread of God is He who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." **:34** Then they said to Him, "Lord, give us this bread always." **:35** And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst. **:36** But I said to you that you have seen Me and yet do not believe. **:37** All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out. **:38** For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. **:39** This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last day.

4.) It's only Jesus - who **can answer** your question

Only Jesus is qualified to answer you !!!

Because that's true - the Bible says...

Job 14:14

If a man dies, shall he live *again*?

John 11:25

"I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. :26 And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die.

Do you believe this?"

Jesus answers "our question" by asking a question...

Do you believe this?"

pisteu/w **pisteuo**, pist-yoo'-o; - to have faith in, upon, or on someone or something. to put your weight in or on. to rest in...

are you resting in Jesus today ?

(you know the answer to that question do you)

1Cor. 15:3

For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, :4 and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,

Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. :29
Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart,

My burden is light.”
