*as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue,*

**INTRODUCTION:      Reading of the Text                      1:5-11**

Peter Authored 2 books of the Bible,  
1st. & 2nd. Peter.

**2 Timothy 3:16**

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,

**2 Peter 1:20-21**

.....knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, <sup>21</sup> for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

The Point of Peter's First Letter was to *encourage the church that "Grace" was Surrounding them even in the midst of their darkest hour.*

His Second Letter Challenged them regarding

*the Knowledge of God. That to know God is to experience the greatest personal relation that man can have.*

**FAITH MAKES '1' GREAT ASSUMPTION...**

and that is that your faith is in an object or person that is far greater than who you are yourself.

**True Christian Faith is anchored on the facts  
"Our Faith Founded Upon Facts"**

Just as a child is born and begins to grow, you will see signs of development  
you can always tell...

**#1 - Sight**

A child first makes eye contact. The color, the size, the shape

**#2 - Touch**

The vision is then heightened by the experience of introduction. The introduction to texture and composition.  
is it soft or hard, is it rough or smooth

**#3 - Possession**

It is acquired and made their own. They begin to name the toy or talk to it, or it becomes there friend - by  
familiarity

**#4 - Sharing**

The object is then shared with others in confidence that it is truly yours and good and that your friends need  
to experience what you have

**In A Real Way - Faith in God is much like that**

#1 - There is that first contact {Sight} Who God is. With your eyes you begin to see...

#2 - You sense the nature of God {Touch} How He is...

#3 - Is {Possession}. You decide to make Him your Personal Lord & Savior

#4 - The natural outflow is to {Share} with others the joy and life and meaning

**vv. 5-7**

the development of the 'divine nature'

#### The Development of Faith

**Romans 10:17**

...faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

#### **Verse 5-7**

*But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith **virtue**, to virtue **knowledge**, to knowledge **self-control**, to self-control **perseverance**, to perseverance **godliness**, to godliness **brotherly kindness**, and to brotherly kindness **love**.*

#### **Verse 5a**

***(the) for this very reason***

Pulls us back to verses 3 & 4

*That we have all **power** available to live this life thru to the end vv. 3*

*And that we have been given **great precious promises** form God vv. 4*

- \* **Great GRK 3176 megistos (meg'-is-tos)**  
a superlative meaning the very greatest. An exceeding great, greatness. Something greater then life (mega!!!)
- \* **Precious GRK 5093 timios (tim'-ee-os)**  
being of ultimate valuable, of priceless cost, having the highest honor

**FAITH IS WHAT SEPARATES CHRISTIANS  
FROM ALL OTHER PEOPLE OF THE WORLD**

Others may have faith - but their faith is fixed upon a sure thing - the right thing

# A Healthy Faith is Biblically Based faith

anything less is a defective faith at best  
THAT WILL EVENTUALLY LEAD YOU ASTRAY

## Verse 5b

Growth will take every bit of Effort and Energy

*giving all diligence,*

- \* **Diligence, GRK 4710 spoude (spoo-day')**  
to be "speeding" about. To have an eagerness and urgency

### Meaning This:

It will take every bit of effort on our part + the power given to us by God to fight and resist the evil of this age

the recipe for making a;  
godly life

## Verse 5c

add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge,

1a) Growing is a Planned Event

**!!!add!!!**

the word 'add' here is where we get the English word chorus or choreograph. To orchestrate a movement of music or a theater play

## The list of ingredients

1st. Add a cup of

- \* **Virtue GRK 703 arete (ar-et'-ay)**  
moral excellence or goodness of character. It's the internal thoughts and motives (GOD RECONSTRUCTS THOSE THINGS)

## 2nd. an ounce of

- \* **knowledge** **GRK 1108 gnosis (gno'-sis)**  
not intellectual knowledge but the knowledge that leads to the action, a true science.

**True Knowledge Must be Mixed with Faith**  
(this is the Christian experience)

### A Serious Warning About Knowledge Alone:

**Knowledge (knowl0edge (nÄl2sj) n.**

1. Is being in the state or position of knowing and being Familiar with, aware of, or having come to an understanding gained through study.

**That's Not Bad - But Knowledge Left Alone**  
**- Can be Disastrous thing...**

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**It leads to pride...**

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**What You & I Know Must Be Applied to Life**

**It's the doing of what you know  
that is humbling to the soul**

**2 Timothy 3:7**

always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

**Hebrews 4:1-2**

...let us be careful lest any of you seem to have come short of it. <sup>2</sup> For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in those who heard it.

## 3rd. A tablespoon of

- \* **Self-control** **GRK 1466 egkrateia (eng-krat'-i-ah)**  
having your desires and passions placed under guard before God. Calling on God to help you watch yourself

## 4th. A half cup of

\* **perseverance**      **GRK 5281 hupomone (hoop-om-on-ay')**  
cheerful hopeful endurance, a deep constancy a  
patient continuance (in a hostile setting - latter days)

### **Romans 15:4**

For whatever things were written before were written for our learning, that we through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have hope.

## *The Never Giving Up ~ Or Giving In*

Sense the Urgency and Pleading of Peter Here

It's Exactly what Jesus meant when He said;

### **Matthew 24:13**

"But he who endures to the end shall be saved.

### **1 Peter 1:13**

Therefore, prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on **the grace** to be given you - when Jesus Christ appears.

### **Psalm 37:23-24**

The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD, and He delights in his way. Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; for the LORD upholds him with His hand.

*Christian - Don't Give Up, Don't Stop Doing What is Right, Don't give in to the Pressures of the World - Hang in there - the end is near (the beginning)*

### **Romans 5:1-5**

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>2</sup> through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. <sup>3</sup> And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; <sup>4</sup> and perseverance, character; and character, hope. (The HOPE here is our Going to Heaven) <sup>5</sup> **Now hope does not disappoint**, (why not?) because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

## 5th. Add a full cup of

\* **Godliness**                    **GRK 2150 eusebeia (yoo-seb'-i-ah)**  
GOD-likeness. True piety and holiness. Being clean and pure  
it's the "doing what Jesus would do" kinda stuff

----- **wwjd** -----

A pointer - godliness is a lasting attractiveness. It's a result of knowing God

## The first '5' qualities are internal

(Regarding ourselves toward god)

## The last '2' qualities are external

(Regarding ourselves toward others)

### 6th. a pinch of

\* **Brotherly kindness**                    **GRK Philadelphia (fil-ad-el-fee'-ah);**  
having and showing kindness toward  
your fellow Christian

#### 1 John 3:16-17

By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought  
to lay down our lives for the brethren. <sup>17</sup> But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in  
need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the  
love of God abide in him?

### 7th. And a bucket of

\* **Love**                    **GRK 26 agape (ag-ah'-pay)**  
affection that leads to benevolence;  
to determine to provide ALL that is within ones power to bless  
another

## **AGAPE' - THE GREATEST MANIFESTATION OF LOVE**

**It's the act of blessing another  
without desiring or requiring anything in return**

**It's a selfless love - an undying love  
- *an unchanging love***

## IT'S, THE LOVE OF GOD

**John 3:16**

"For God so **loved** the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

**John 11:5**

Now Jesus **loved** Martha and her sister and Lazarus.

**John 13:1**

Now before the feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the Father, having **loved** His own who were in the world, He **loved** them to the end.

**John 17:23**

"I am in them, and You Father are in Me; that they may be made complete in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have **loved** them as You have **loved** Me.

((The Father Loves Jesus, Just as much as He loves Me))

**1 John 4:11**

Beloved, if God so **loved** us, we also ought to **love** one another.

when you "agape" someone,  
*you are loving them with a giving love. The love of God has been revealed  
to us by actions, by doing*

**Galatians 5:22-23**

**But the fruit of the Spirit is love**..... joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control.

**Against such there is no law.**

**The Law**, *(the big ten) has to run away in shame in the prescience of love - the fruit of the Holy Spirit*

# - Just Add Water

**John 7:37**

On the last day, that great day of the feast Jesus stood and cried out, saying,  
"If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink...."

The Priest would walk over to the Spring Gihon and take a pitcher of cool, clear water and return back to the temple porch. Quietly before everyone he would pour it out the steps, letting it flow down toward the people. This was done to remained them of the water that God provided to the children of Israel through the wilderness years

**vv. 8-9**

**Verse 8**

For if these things are **yours** and **abound**, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**If We...**

If we purpose in our hearts to follow Him, then we will pursue these things...  
the result is a wonderful, healthy, productive and exciting Christian life

.....THE AWESOMENESS OF FOLLOWING GOD AWAITS US.....

**If Not...**

Then we will experience the Stunted Spiritual Growth of the Carnal Christian

**Verse 9**

For he who lacks these things is **shortsighted**, even to **blindness**,  
and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins.

**This is written about the backslidden Christian (the carnal believer) the one has who Has Forgotten!!!**

- \* **Shortsighted**      **GRK 5185 tuphlos (toof-los')**  
opaque (as if smoky or unclear. Confused and unable to know where to be going
- \* **Blindness**      **GRK 3467 myopidzo (moo-ope-ad'-zo)**  
to squint or shut the eyes, not being able to see far away cannot see far off.

## **The Bible Warns Us About the Nature of Sin**

**Hebrews 11:25b**  
SIN HAS IT'S MOMENTS....enjoy the passing pleasures of sin,

**Matthew 6:22-23**  
"The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are good, your whole body will be full of light. <sup>23</sup> But if your eyes are bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light within you is darkness, how great is that darkness!

### **THE CHRISTIAN CAN LOSE HIS VISION IF HE CONTINUES TO PLAY IN THE DARK**

### **They have become like the World**

They act like the world they talk like the world

**3.) Faith is to Grow Up Confident      vv. 10-11**

**Verse 10**

Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble;

### **WHAT GOD HAS PROVIDED, WE ARE EXPECTED TO TAKE IT AND USE IT FOR ETERNITY**

# It is a cooperation -

THE CHRISTIAN **WHO KNOWS** THAT THEY BELONG TO JESUS WILL NEVER STUMBLE (FALL) BUT WILL PROVE BY A CONSISTENT LIFE THAT THEY ARE GOD'S CHILD...

## Proverbs 2:1-3

My son, if you receive my words, and treasure my commands within you, <sup>2</sup> So that you incline your ear to wisdom, and apply your heart to understanding; <sup>3</sup> Yes, if you cry out for discernment, and lift up your voice for understanding,

## Philippians 2:12-13

Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling..... **(that sounds pretty defeating) ...**

<sup>13</sup> for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.

## John 17:1-3, 8

Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: "Father, the hour has come.
