INTRODUCTION;

The Old Testament is full of New Testament models
Here Jacob, under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit will prophecy the future of Israel.

Verse 1

Jacob is now in his glory !!!

The Spirit of God comes upon him, he begins the 12 prophetic revelations regarding the future of Isreal in the lives of his 12 son's.

Verse 3-4

Reuben, by birthright, he should have been the head

History shows us that no one from the tribe of Reuben ever excelled.

Reuben & Bilhah's sexual union revealed his character.

Verse 5-7

Simeon & Levi,

bonded by violence and ill-tempered. Rebellious men and so was their offspring.

Verse 8-12,

Judah, not Joseph's descendants, but from Judah's line will come the messiah, Jesus. Judah was the most responsible of them as he acted out the role of the mediator (Benjamin & the cup)

Verse 9

A Lion's welp or (young, powerful Lion). The Lion from the tribe of Judah

Verse 10

The scepter shall not depart... (a problem to the Jew)

Shiloh is the root from where we get Shalom, Peace

Him *that is* Shiloh, Peace

Isaiah 9:6

For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, everlasting Father (father of eternity), Prince of "Shiloh" ...Peace.

Verse 11-12

Refers to the 2nd. Coming of Jesus Christ in the Tribulation Period.

Verse 13

Zebulun is the one who settled in the northwest upon the coast

Verse 14-15

Issachar,

as big & strong as an ox but as lazy as a bum. A lazy, serving tribe.

Verse 16-17

Dan dwelt in the upper Jordan area.

Verse 17 *may be a reference to the antichrist.*

It is believed that the antichrist may very well arise from the tribe of Dan due to the fact that he is absent from the 144,000 virgin, male Hebrew speaking Jewish Billy Graham's see Revelation 7:5

Verse 18

is an insert from Jacob as he exclaims...

**“ I have waited for your
salvation, O'Lord !”**

Salvation, O' Lord !

are two nouns

Salvation *HEB* **yeshuw` ah (yesh-oo'-aw)**
the deliverer, the one who saves

O' Lord *HEB* **Yehovah (yeh-ho-vaw')**
(the) self-Existent or Eternal God, Jehovah

James 3:3-10

Indeed, we put bits in horses' mouths that they may obey us, and we turn their whole body. ⁴ Look also at ships: although they are so large and are driven by fierce winds, they are turned by a very small rudder wherever the pilot desires. ⁵ Even so the tongue is a little member and boasts great things. See how great a forest a little fire kindles! ⁶ And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so "set among our members" that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire by hell. ⁷ For every kind of beast and bird, of reptile and creature of the sea, is tamed and has been tamed by mankind. ⁸ But no

*man can tame the tongue. It is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.*⁹ With it we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude of God.¹⁰ Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be so.
