INTRODUCTION

to the text

1 Samuel 1:12-20

It was a Critical Time in Israel

The Period of the Judges of Israel was about to come to an end with Judge Samuel, - But God had determined that Samuel would be the First of the Prophets of Israel as well...

2 And he had two wives: the name of one was Ha'-nah, and the name of the other Peninnah. And Peninnah had children, **but Hannah had none.**



Hannah heb (khan-naw' - grace) whose name means “special, chosen, one favored by God – or graced by God”

Graced by God

Was this some sort of a cosmic joke?

The Grace of God is Always Enough

2 Corinthians 12:8-10

8 Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. 9 And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. 10 Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

SHE STAYED AT PRAYING

Luke 11:9-10

9 "So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 10 For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

Magnifies our frailty

b) Blinds us to our effectiveness

vv. 12-13

Eli watched her mouth. 13 **Now Hannah spoke in her heart**; only her lips moved, but her voice was not heard. Therefore Eli thought she was drunk.

Jeremiah 29:10-14

11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. 12 Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. 13 **And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.**

Magnifies our frailty

c) Overpowers us for defeat

vv. 14-15

So Eli said to her, "How long will you be drunk? Put your wine away from you!" 15 And Hannah answered and said, "No, my lord, I am a woman of sorrowful spirit. I have drunk neither wine nor intoxicating drink, but have poured out my soul before the LORD.

Tired, Exhausted, Worn, & Fatigued

Life, When The Bottom Drops Out

2) Often Creates a Critical Eye

vv. 16-17

16 Do not consider your maidservant a wicked woman, for out of the abundance of my **complaint** and **grief** I have spoken until now." 17 Then Eli answered and said, "Go in peace, and the God of Israel grant your petition which you have asked of Him."

a) When we begin to justify our position

v. 16

Do not consider your maidservant a wicked woman, for out of the abundance of my **complaint** and **grief** I have spoken until now

Hannah's Example

There is no record of her pouting or whining or demanding

1 Peter 5:5-6

"God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble." 6 Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time,

Life, When The Bottom Drops Out

Often Creates a Critical Eye

b) When we begin to attack the position of others

v.17

Then Eli answered and said, "Go in peace..."

"Go in peace"

To attack the position of others is human..

Because every human has their faults and failures, there is no scarcity of material to attack

Often Creates a Critical Eye

c.) When we begin to build walls of defense

v.17

"And the God of Israel grant your petition which you have asked of Him."

Self-Defense is a Natural Response

Ephesians 4:30-31

Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you,

Hebrews 12:13-15

14 Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord: 15 looking diligently lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled;

v. 19

Then they rose early in the morning and **worshipped before the LORD**, and returned and came to their house at Ramah.

c) *Cynicism says, "none are with me"*

v. 19

Hannah's Example

Often Builds a Cynical Heart and Mind

d) *Cynicism says, "Be depressed"*

20 So it came to pass in the process of time that Hannah conceived and bore a son, and called his name Samuel, saying, "Because I have asked for him from the LORD."

Rejoice always, 17 pray without ceasing, 18 in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

Hannah Turned to God

Yehovah (yeh-ho-vaw')

(the) self-Existent or Eternal; Jehovah

Hosts

The organizer of war, the one who assembles an army.
To launch a campaign against hardship, worship):

#1

Look on the affliction of Your maidservant

*To arrive, to make an appearance,
to show yourself, to take the case*

#2

and **remember** me,

To count how long, to consider the scale, to recognize and evaluate

#3

and not **forget** Your maidservant,

To keep forefront in mind, to hold as a priority

#4

but will **give** Your maidservant a male child,

To grant, to assign, to appoint, to provide, to hand out

Then I will give him to the LORD all the days of his life, and no razor shall come upon his head."
