b.) You need to “Embrace” God’s Specific plan

This Where Trust and Faith Come In

Understand and Determine

“That God is Personally
Interested in Your Life”

Psalm 139:17-18

How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! 18 If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand;

2.) God is “Performing” a specific plan for you vv.4-6

a.) It usually doesn't make human sense

v.4

So he passed through the mountains of Ephraim and through the land of Shall-I-sha, **but they did not find them**. Then they passed through the land of Sha-a-lim, **but they were not there**. Then he passed through the land of the Benjamites, **but they did not find them**.

Chasing Donkey's Doesn't Make Sense

(UNLESS GOD IS IT)

This is a very hard pill
for us to swallow

While they're out looking, they are actually getting
closer to God's will be performed in their lives...

Even the "Looking" Process is
of God

God is "Performing" a specific plan for you

b.) to bring you to the point of asking directions v.5

5 When they had come to the land of Zuff, Saul said to his servant who was with him, "Come, let us return, lest my father cease caring about the donkeys and become worried about us." 6 And he said to him, "Look now, there is in this city a man of God, and he is an honorable man; all that he says surely comes to pass. **So let us go there; perhaps he can show us the way that we should go.**"

**When You Can't Find Your Donkey's
You'll Inevitably – Ask God for Help**

"Since my daughters were very little we have always taught them to ask God for whatever...

3.) God will be "Controlling" the specific plan vv.15-20

a.) He will always be exact

vv.15-16a

Now the LORD had told Samuel in his ear - the day before Saul came, saying, 16 "Tomorrow about this time I will send you a man from the land of Benjamin,

God is Speaking **To** Samuel
and **Through** Samuel

Regarding His Will,
God is Very Specific

But There Are His Specific
Exceptions

Listen How Vaguely Specific This Is

Hebrews 11:8

By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going.

God will be "Controlling" the specific plan

b.) Others will be involved in your plan

v.17

And when Samuel saw Saul, the LORD said to him, **"There he is, the man of whom I spoke to you. This one shall reign over My people."**

He Will Often Use People to
Deliver the Message
or to Confirm the Message

THE LORD DID THIS THROUGHOUT
THE GOSPELS AND ACTS

God will be "Controlling" the specific plan

c.) He will always provide what's needed vv.18-20

18 Then Saul drew near to Samuel in the gate, and said, "Please tell me, where is the seer's house?" 19 And Samuel answered Saul and said, "I am the seer. **Go up before me to the high place, for you shall eat with me today; and tomorrow I will let you go and will tell you all that is in your heart.** 20 "But as for your donkeys that were lost three days ago, do not be anxious about them, for they have been found..."

...And on whom is all the desire of Israel? Is it not on you and on all your father's house?"

"And let it be, when these signs come to you, that you do
as the occasion demands;
for God is with you.
