## The Lord Loves His People!

Jeremiah 3:14a-15

"Return, O backsliding children," says the LORD; "for I am married to you. 15 "And I will give you shepherds (pastors) according to My heart, who will feed you with knowledge and understanding.

**Saul** was the people's choice for king. But God had a whole different KIND of man in mind to shepherd His people.

**Ministry by Assumption,**

Is a common but dangerous thing among "ministers"

What is the Mark of a True Pastor?

*He is to Teach (feed them) & He is to Tend (know them).*

**1.) *It's because God knows all things***

***vv. 1-3***

**a.) Samuel's heart was to be "in-line" with God's heart**

1 Now the LORD said to Samuel, "How long will you mourn for Saul, seeing I have rejected him from reigning over Israel?"

**b.) Samuel is weakened by Saul's ministry**

2 And Samuel said, "How can I go? If Saul hears it, he will kill me."

## Self-Examination of "Self"

2 Corinthians 13:5-6

Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?-- unless indeed you are disqualified. 6 But I trust that you will know that we are not disqualified.

**2.) It's based upon His will being done**

**vv. 4-7**

7 But the LORD said to Samuel,  
"Do not look at his appearance or at the height of his stature, because I have refused him. For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart."

**a.) His will is not biased by earthly powers**

7 For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart."

## **A Jesus-Hearted Ministry**

Psalm 147:10-11

He does not delight in the strength of the horse; he takes no pleasure in the legs of a man. 11  
The LORD takes pleasure in those who fear Him, in those who hope in His mercy.

### ***3.) It will be by the power of the Holy Spirit vv. 8-13***

12 So he sent and brought David in. Now he was ruddy (tanned skin), with bright eyes, (lively) and good-looking (strong features). And the LORD said, "Arise, anoint him; for this is the one!"

### ***a.) The Selection of God is Rooted in Him = Mystery***

The Other Brothers

**It's The Heart - that God is Interested in.**

Genesis 18:25

...Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?

Romans 8:28-30

And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. 29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. 30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

## **b.) The Calling of God is not up to human reason**

11 ...and there he is, **keeping the sheep.**" And Samuel said to Jesse, "Send and bring him. For we will not sit down till he comes here."

1 Chronicles 17:7-8

"I took you from the sheepfold, from following the sheep, to be ruler over My people Israel..."

## **God Made David**

### **God Doesn't Call the Gifted – He Gifts the Called**

Romans 11:29

For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance.

Ephesians 2:10

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

12 So he sent and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, with bright eyes, and good-looking. And the LORD said, "Arise, anoint him; for this is the one!" 13 Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers; **and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward.** So Samuel arose and went to Ramah.

Ephesians 5:18

And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation;

But (similar, but contrasting) be **filled** (filled again and again = re-fueled) with the Spirit,

SO DOES THE HOLY SPIRIT

## **"The Promise of the Father"**

Acts 1:4-5

And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me; 5 "for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

## **The filling or baptism OF THE Holy Spirit is very different from baptism BY THE spirit.**

Baptism **BY** THE Holy Spirit is a one-time event at the moment of salvation.

It is an Act of the Holy Spirit placing you into the Body (Church) of Christ. It has nothing to do with water baptism.

**1 Corinthians 12:7-12**

But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: 8 for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. 11 But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills. 12 For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ.

**“The filling or baptism OF THE Holy Spirit is a continuous re-fueling of power in the life of the Christian.”**

The Baptism **IN** THE Holy Spirit  
Is a continuous event - It places the **POWER** of the Holy Spirit upon you, making you **FILLED** for victory and service.  
*It too has nothing to do with water baptism*

Matthew 3:11

"I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

Acts 4:29-31

"Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, 30 "by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus." 31 And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

Acts 1:8

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

## **Paul's Need to be Filled before Take Off**

Acts 9:17

And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit."

## **Rivers of Living Water**

John 7:37-39

On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. 38 "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water (gushing or moving or active water)." 39 But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

**The Jews Would Never Drink from Standing Water  
It was considered dead and poisoned.**

Luke 11:9-13

"So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 10 "For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. 11 "If a son asks for bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? 12 "Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? 13 "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"

John 16:7-11

"...I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. 8 "And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9 "of sin, because they do not believe in Me; 10 "of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; 11 "of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

John 14:16-18

"And I will pray the Father, and He will give you **another Helper**, that He (person) may abide with you forever—even 17 "the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you (para) and will be in (en) you. 18 "I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.
