## **“The Knowable God”**

In everything, the book of Hebrews presents Jesus Christ as the all sufficient and eternal priesthood. In all things Jesus Christ is better than Moses, than Angels, than the law as being centrality of those ministries.

**SUBJECT TOPICALLY REFERENCED UNDER:**

**The better sacrifice, atonement, salvation, redemption, sanctification, justification.**

Hebrews 1:1-2

God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, 2 has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through Whom also He made the worlds;

**THE BOOK OF HEBREWS PRESENTS:  
JESUS CHRIST AS - THE ONE AND ONLY.**

Every way – all of the Scriptures, all of the profits, and all of the events revealed in scripture point to the centrality of Jesus Christ as being the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the Almighty God, and Savior of the world.

**The Author of the Book declares that:**

Hebrews 10:7

“Behold, I have come - In the volume of the book *it is written of Me*  
- To do Your will, O God.’ ”

Quoting Psalms 40:7

John 5:37-39

The Father Himself, who sent Me, has testified of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His form. 38 But you do not have His word abiding in you, because whom He sent, Him you do not believe. 39 You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; *and these are they which testify of Me.*

## of the Biblical account of who Jesus Christ is.

Colossians 2:16-17

So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths, 17 which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ.

Hebrews 10:1-4

For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect. 2 For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, once purified, would have had no more consciousness of sins. 3 But in those sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year. 4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins. :5 Therefore, when Christ came into the world, He said: "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body You have prepared for Me.

The opening of this chapter is very reminiscent of Genesis 1:1, Meaning that the Bible assumes that the reader knows that God is the Creator

Genesis 1:1

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

( bam, mic drop, thumbs up, booyah)

**And right here – The God of the Bible assumes that you are aware that He speaks and is speaking to mankind**

Normally Assumptions are not good things – however in this case, God assumes that every human being is aware of His existence and that He speaks.

Psalms 97:6

The heavens declare His righteousness,  
and all the peoples see His glory.

Psalms 19:1-3

The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His  
handiwork. :2 Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night reveals  
knowledge. :3 There is no speech nor language where their voice is not heard.

Psalms 53:1-2

The fool has said in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, and have  
done abominable iniquity; There is none who does good. 2 God looks down from heaven  
upon the children of men, To see if there are any who understand, who seek God.

Romans 1:18-20

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and  
unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, 19  
because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it  
to them. 20 For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are  
clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal  
power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,

How many times do we read in the Bible when the scripture says  
*"and the Lord said," "the Lord spoke saying,"*  
and *"God called out and said..."*

**The Entire Premise of the Bible is:  
that God has made a way for man to come back to God.**

Acts 17:24-28

God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth,

does not dwell in temples made with hands. 25 Nor is He worshiped with men's hands, as though He needed anything, since He gives to all life, breath, and all things. 26 And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined their preappointed times and the boundaries of their dwellings, 27 so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us; 28 for in Him we live and move and have our being.

His Unchanging Person presides over all His ways.

Acts 17:30-31

Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent, 31 because He has appointed a day on which He will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead.”

Ways grk: polutropos; avenues, directions, paths, {what would appear to us to be "options" is the fact that God can do anything He desires}

Hebrews 13:8

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Malachi 3:6

"For I am the LORD, I do not change;

2c.) He ordains the message

vs. 1f

Verse 1f

spoke in time past to the fathers  
by the prophets,

- He Spoke by Angels in the book of Genesis by appearances.
- He Spoke by Moses to the people of Israel in Exodus.
- He Spoke by an earthly Priesthood in Leviticus.

He Spoke by the Prophets in the bulk of the O.T.

Hosea 12:10

I have also spoken by the prophets, and have multiplied visions;  
I have given symbols through the witness of the prophets."

3a.) He has gifted Himself

vs. 2a

Verse 2a

2 has in these last days spoken to us by His Son,

"Has in these LAST DAYS spoken to us by His Son,"

Galatians 4:4

But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son,  
born of a woman, born under the law,

Fullness GRK ple-ro-ma (play'-ro-mah) at the exact or appointed or completed time, at fulfillment of the volume of time.

“Has in these LAST DAYS spoken to us by His Son,”  
This is one more reason why we believe in the Dispensations of God.  
Meaning that God “orders things” or “God appoints things.”  
In a literal way. Creation, Israel, History, the Church, The Last Days...

It is the time between (1) the first coming of Jesus 2,000 years ago and (2) His second coming: His return to Israel

The Final word to mankind is in and through Jesus Christ.  
Jesus came so that we might know the Father. Jesus was and is “The Final Word” to mankind. The book of Revelation is Known as the FIFTH Gospel,

Revelation 1:1  
“The Revelation of Jesus Christ”

Revelation GRK apokalupsis (ap-ok-al'-oop-sis) the unveiling, the unmasking, the full and total disclosure of Jesus Christ.

Jesus is God’s ultimate “communication” to man.  
God the Father wrote Himself into the script through Jesus His Son

The Shakespearian Analogy  
Shakespeare was (the creator) of Hamlet (Hamlet was the created).

The Creator of the Story  
Has Written Himself into The Story.  
A warning to those seeking to violate /  
reinterpret His revelation.

“If God speaks to you tonight, He will say something that you can read in the Bible,  
He will repeat that which He has already spoken before. - - There is no new truth,

No new revelation or additions needed to add to the Scriptures” – Jack

Revelation 22:18-19

For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; :19 and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

“I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me, ‘You are My Son, Today I have begotten You. 8 Ask of Me, and I will give You The nations for Your inheritance, And the ends of the earth for Your possession.

Isaiah 66:1-2

Thus says the LORD: “Heaven is My throne, And earth is My footstool. Where is the house that you will build Me? And where is the place of My rest? 2 For all those things My hand has made, And all those things exist,” Says the LORD. “But on this one will I look: On him who is poor and of a contrite spirit, And who trembles at My word.

Verse 2c

2c through Whom also He made the worlds;

John 1:1-3 (14)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. :2 He was in the beginning with God. :3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. :14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

Colossians 1:16

For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth,  
visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers.  
All things were created through Him and for Him.

1 Corinthians 8:6 ESV

yet for us there is one God, the Father, from whom are all things and for whom  
we exist, and one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom are all things  
and through whom we exist.
