In everything, the book of Hebrews presents Jesus Christ as the all-sufficient and eternal priest.  
In all things Jesus Christ is better than Moses, than Angels, than the Law, being the centrality of those ministries.

rest, hope, promises, oaths, immutability, blessings, God's faithfulness.

### Hebrews 13:7-9

Remember those who rule over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of their conduct. **8** Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. **9** Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines. For it is good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them.

In our last study together, which was part three of this message series

I gave you exactly 100 versus regarding the Deity and the mission and the ministry and the conclusion of God's redemptive work through God himself, Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

The verses and the passages of scripture that I provided to you and all that what God has revealed to us made the indisputable, irrefutable argument that Jesus Christ is not only the Son of God and Savior, but He was, He is and is forever - The resurrected God who became our atonement, that through Him, we have the forgiveness of sins and the assurance of eternal life.

### 1 Timothy 3:16

Without controversy great is the mystery of godliness:  
God was manifested in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen by angels, preached among the gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

### **1 Corinthians 15:24-26**

Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. **25** For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. **26** The last enemy that will be destroyed is death.

This passage occurs at the close of the 1,000 year reign of Christ

(and for the replacement theology goofs – News Flash - Jesus Christ Himself will physically, literally, Rule and Reign from the City of Jerusalem in the Nation of Israel where He establishes His Politics Of Him being “The KING of KINGS and LORD of LORDS.”)

**9** Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines. For it is good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them.

Here’s the Big Beautiful Brain Bender for you

1. **When** did God **decide** to love you?
2. **When** did God **decide** for you to believe in Him?
3. **When** did God **decide** to redeem you back to Himself?

The answer is literally impossible for us to fathom.

### Ephesians 2:4-10

But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, **5** even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), **6** and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, **7** that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. **8** For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, **9** not of works, lest anyone should boast. **10** For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

### Impossible Because...

There was never a time when God decided to love you.

There was never a time when God didn't know that you'd believe in Him.

There was never a "when" God made a plan to redeem you.

3a.) Love kept those in the past

vs. 9a

**9** Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines.

God's Love is a Pro-Tective Love and because  
that is true - His love toward us is also a Pro-Active Love

**Carried** grk: periphero  
to be dragged up and away, influenced, swayed, to be carried about or carried away from shelter and out into the open. to be pulled from moorings and into the open ocean.

**Various** grk: poikilos  
many colors or multiple colors – implying that which is attractive to the eye and or to the ears.

**Strange** grk: xenos  
a foreign or strange word or teachings. rejected teachings and doctrines. That which is contrary to sound biblical doctrine.

His Protective & Proactive Love is a Violent Love.  
( let me explain )

Verse 9b

For it is good

**1 John 3:14**

We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love his brother abides in death.

The Grace of God at Work In us and Through us.

**1 Thessalonians 4:9-12**

But concerning brotherly love you have no need that I should write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to love one another; **10** and indeed you do so toward all the brethren who are in all Macedonia. But we urge you, brethren, that you increase more and more; **11** that you also aspire to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you, **12** that you may walk properly toward those who are outside, and *that* you may lack nothing.

Verse 9c
