In all things Jesus Christ is better than Moses, than Angels, than the Law, being the centrality of those ministries.

We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat. **11** For (because) the bodies of those animals, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned outside the camp. **12** Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate. **13** Therefore let us go forth to Him, outside the camp, bearing His reproach. **14** For here we have no continuing city, (in this world) but we seek the one to come. **15** Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name. **16** But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

We Are Reminded That – In the Closing Arguments
in This - Our Last Chapter of the Book of Hebrews – And there is a
Great Summation found in Verse 9 of this Chapter

Hebrews 13:9

Not to be carried about with various and strange doctrines.
For it is good that the heart be established by GRACE, *not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them.*

Jeremiah 31:31-33

Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah - **32** not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day *that* I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD.

33 But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

1 Kings 8:27-29a

“But will God indeed dwell on the earth? Behold, heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot contain You. How much less this temple which I have built! **28** Yet regard the prayer of Your servant and his supplication, O LORD my God, and listen to the cry and the prayer which Your servant is praying before You today: **29** that Your eyes may be open toward this temple night and day, toward the place of which You said, “My name shall be there,’ ”

2 Thessalonians 2:1-10

Now, brethren, concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him, we ask you, **2** not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though the Day of Christ had come. **3** Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, *(this is where we are tonight – at that comma)* and *(then or next)* the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, **4** who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that HE SITS AS GOD IN THE TEMPLE OF GOD, *(where? In the temple)* showing himself that he is God....

5 Do you not remember that when I was still with you, I told you these things? **6** And now you know what is restraining, that he may be revealed in his own time. **7** For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way. **8** And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming. **9** The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, **10** and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

The Danger of Missing Out on Having a (Correct) Personal Relationship
with The Almighty God.

David had such a Relationship

Psalms 27:4-6

One thing I have desired of the LORD, that will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the LORD All the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to inquire in His temple (*in what temple*) . **5** For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion; In the secret place of His tabernacle, He shall hide me; He shall set me high upon a rock. **6** And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me; therefore, I will offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the LORD.

What Goes Up - Must Come From an Altar

Verse 11

11 For (because) the bodies of those animals, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned outside the camp.

It is an offering of substitute. Throughout all of human history – religions, cultures and cults have all sought to offer up the most costly sacrifices possible to their gods.

Their choicest harvest / animals / daughters / sons.

The Inca's

“No location was exempt from the recruitment of these child sacrifices; they could come from any region of the empire. The male victims were no older than ten years of age and girls could be up to age sixteen. Regardless, all must be virgins when chosen; they had to be viewed as innocent and perfect - unblemished by not even a freckle, scar or birthmark. The Inca believed that only the purest children were worthy enough to be sent to the gods, as in the afterlife they would function as the people's representatives in the afterlife. For many families it was a great honor to have one's child chosen for the ceremony. Royalty were not exempt rather desired as a child from nobility were believed to be an even more valued sacrifice for the benefit of the Inca Empire.”

1.) Must come from an altar

vs. 10-11

Hebrews 13:12

12 Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate.

Leviticus 16

Tells us of God's ordained method of atonement. Two animals were to be sacrificed, #1 for the sins of the high Priest and #2 for the nation (scapegoat)

2 Corinthians 5:21

For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Isaiah 53:6b

And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

Hebrews 10:1

For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, *and* not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect.

John 1:29,35-36

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

:35 Again, the next day, John stood with two of his disciples. **36** And looking at Jesus as He walked, John said, "Behold the Lamb of God!"

John 19:17-19

And Jesus, bearing His cross, went out to a place called the Place of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha, **18** where they crucified Him, and two others with Him, one on either side, and Jesus in the center. **19** Now Pilate wrote a title and put it on the cross. And the writing was: JESUS OF NAZARETH, THE KING OF THE JEWS.

Leviticus 4:21,23b-24

You shall carry the bull outside the camp, and burn it as he burned the first bull. It is a sin offering for the assembly, he shall bring as his offering a kid of the goats, a male without blemish. **24** And he shall lay his hand on the head of the goat, and kill it at the place where they kill the burnt offering before the LORD. It is a sin offering.

Hebrews 9:6-14

Now when these things had been thus prepared, the priests always went into the first part of the tabernacle, performing *the services*. **7** But into the second part the high priest *went* alone once a year, not without blood, which he offered for himself and *for* the people's sins *committed* in ignorance; **8** the Holy Spirit indicating this, that the way into the Holiest of All was not yet made manifest while the first tabernacle was still standing. **9** It *was* symbolic for the present time in which both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make him who performed the service perfect in regard to the conscience. **10** *concerned* only with foods and drinks, various washings, and fleshly ordinances imposed until the time of reformation. **11** But Christ came *as* High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. **12** Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. **13** For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, **14** how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Hebrews 10:1-5

For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect. **2** For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, once purified, would have had no more consciousness of sins. **3** But in those sacrifices, there is a reminder of sins every year. **4** For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins. **5** Therefore, when He (Messiah) came into the world, He said: "*Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body You have prepared for Me.*"
(Psalm 40:6)

Hebrews 10:10-12

By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once *for all*. **11** And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. **12** But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God,

Verse 13-14

13 Therefore let us go forth to Him, outside the camp, bearing His reproach. **14** For (because) here (in this world) we have no continuing city, but we seek the one to come.

WHAT GOES UP

3.) Will last forever & ever - amen vs. 15-16

Verse 15

15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.

Psalms 34:1-6

I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth. **2** My soul shall make its boast in the LORD;

The humble shall hear of it and be glad. **3** Oh, magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt His name together. **4** I sought the LORD, and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears. **5**

They looked to Him and were radiant, And their faces were not ashamed. **6** This poor man cried out, and the LORD heard him, And saved him out of all his troubles.

16 But do not forget to do GOOD and to SHARE, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.
