Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account. Let them do so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you. **18** Pray for us; for we are confident that we have a good conscience, in all things desiring to live honorably. **19** But I especially urge *you* to do this, that I may be restored to you the sooner.

God is at Work in "The Times and the Seasons" - of Our Lives,  
Yet - these times & seasons are drawing to a close.

**Romans 13:11-12**

And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is nearer than when we first believed. **12** The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore, let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light.

**John 9:4**

I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day;  
the night is coming when no one can work.

By the way – the coming and going of a dispensation does not cancel the truth of the previous dispensation – it enhances it – makes it more clear as time goes on.

**Ephesians 1:10**

That in the **dispensation** of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth - in Him.

**Hebrews 1:1-2a**

God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, **2** has in these last days spoken to us by His Son,

**Ephesians 3:2**

If indeed you have heard of the **dispensation** of the grace of God which was given to me for you,

times of administration, a session or term or epoch of ages

**Galatians 4:4-5**

But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, **5** to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

1.) We are all His ministers

vs. 17

Verse 17

Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account. Let them do so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you.

2.) We are all His Witnesses

vs. 18

Verse 18

**18** Pray for us; for we are confident that we have a good conscience, in all things - desiring to live honorably

“All Ministry Must Come From Authentic Humility.

**1 Corinthians 4:6-7,10-16**

Now these things, brethren, I have figuratively transferred to myself and Apollos for your sakes, that you may learn in us not to think beyond what is written, that none of you may be puffed up on behalf of one against the other. **7** For who makes you differ from another? And what do you have that you did not receive? Now if you did indeed receive it, why do you boast as if you had not received it? **10** We are fools for Christ's sake, but you are wise in Christ! We are weak, but you are strong! You are distinguished, but we are dishonored! **11** To the present hour we both hunger and thirst, and we are poorly clothed, and beaten, and homeless. **12** And we labor, working with our own hands. Being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we endure; **13** being defamed, we entreat. We have been made as the filth of the world, the offscouring of all things until now. **14** I do not write these things to shame you, but as my beloved children I warn you. **15** For though you might have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet you do not have many fathers; for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel. **16** Therefore I urge you, imitate me.

## **THERE'S ONLY ONE TRUE MINISTRY**

**3.) We are all His Children – In Christ Jesus !**

**vs. 19**

Verse 19

**19** But I especially urge you to do this, that I may be restored to you the sooner.

ALL {IN} THE FAMILY OF GOD ARE BORN {AGAIN}  
IN TO THE FAMILY OF GOD

**1 John 5:1**

Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ - - is born of God, and everyone who loves Him who begot also loves him who is begotten of Him.

**Here is the Qualifier;**

**John 3:1-19**

There was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. **2** This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him." **3** Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." **4** Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" **5** Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. **6** That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. **7** Do not marvel that I said to you, "You must be born again.' **8** The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit." **9** Nicodemus answered and said to Him, "How can these things be?" **10** Jesus answered and said to him, "Are you the teacher of Israel, and do not know these things? **11** Most assuredly, I say to you, We speak what We know and testify what We have seen, and you do not receive Our witness. **12** If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you heavenly things? **13** No one has ascended to heaven but He who came down from heaven, *that is*, the Son of Man who is in heaven. **14** And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, **15** that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. **16**

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. **17** For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. **18** “He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. **19** And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

## “That Jesus is The Christ (Messiah)”

### **1 John 1:7**

But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

### **1 John 2:29**

If you know that He is righteous, you know that everyone who practices righteousness is born of Him.

### **1 John 3:9**

Whoever has been born of God does not sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot sin, because he has been born of God.

### **1 John 4:7**

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.

### **1 John 5:4**

For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world - our faith.

### **1 John 5:18**

We know that whoever is born of God does not sin; but he who has been born of God keeps himself, and the wicked one does not touch him.

### **2 Corinthians 5:17**

**Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.**

### **Philippians 2:13**

**for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.**

### **Romans 8:1**

**There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.**

### **Galatians 2:20**

**I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.**
