## **Introduction to the Topic**

## **Deceiving spirits and doctrine of demons**

**1 Timothy 4:1**

Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving  
heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons,

## There will be false prophets, and false teachers among us

### 2 Peter 2:1-2

But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, *and* bring on themselves swift destruction. **2** And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed.

## They will exercise powerful but deceiving miracles

### Matthew 24:3-5,24-25

Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, “Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?” **4** And Jesus answered and said to them: “Take heed that no one deceives you. **5** For many will come in My name, saying, ‘I am the Christ,’ and will deceive many, **24** For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, **if** possible, even the elect. **25** See, I have told you **beforehand**.”

### Matthew 24:45-50

“Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his master made ruler over his household, to give them food in due season? **46** Blessed is that servant whom his master, when he comes, will find so doing. **47** Assuredly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all his goods. **48** But if that evil servant says in his heart, ‘My master is delaying his coming,’ **49** and begins to beat his fellow servants, and to eat and drink with the drunkards, **50** the master of that servant will come on a day when he is not looking for him and at an hour that he is not aware of.”

## They will deny, by watering down the doctrines of Jesus Christ

### 2 Timothy 3:1-5

But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: **2** For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, **3** unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, **4** traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, **5** having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

“But one of the Paramount teachings of false prophets will be #1 that of mocking the return of Jesus Christ both for His church as well as #2 His Second Coming to the nation of Israel and to the Jewish people.”

### 2 Peter 3:2-4 NLT

I want you to remember what the holy prophets said long ago and what our Lord and Savior commanded through your apostles. 3 Most importantly, I want to remind you that in the last days scoffers will come, mocking the truth and following their own desires. 4 They will say, “What happened to the promise that Jesus is coming again? From before the times of our ancestors, everything has remained the same since the world was first created.”

#### 1.) The King's First Coming

### Galatians 4:4-5

But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, 5 to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

### The Advent of The Promised New Covenant

### Jeremiah 31:31-33

“Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah - 32 not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD. 33 But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

### Luke 4:16-21

So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. **17** And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: **18** "The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; **19** To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD (**l**)" **20** Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. ### Malachi 3:1

"Behold, I send My messenger, and he will prepare the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple, Even the Messenger of The Covenant, In whom you delight. Behold, He is coming," Says the LORD of hosts.

## Referencing The First Coming of Jesus Christ

### Matthew 21:1-5

Now when they drew near Jerusalem, and came to Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, **2** saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Loose *them* and bring *them* to Me. **3** And if anyone says anything to you, you shall say, "The Lord has need of them," and immediately he will send them." **4** All this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying: **5** "*Tell the daughter of Zion, 'Behold, your King is coming to you, Lowly, and sitting on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.'*"

( does the Bible teach that Jesus Christ could come back at any time and has that doctrine always been a New Testament doctrine? )

## Here is the **Why**

### 1 Corinthians 15:50-57

Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption. **51** Behold, I tell you a mystery: **we** shall not all sleep, but **we** shall all be changed - **52** in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and **we** shall be **changed**.

*( change = allasso, al-las'-so; to take something and make something different out of the same. to change what was into what is).*

**53** For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality. **54** So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "*Death is swallowed up in victory.*" **55** "*O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?*" **56** The sting of death *is* sin, and the strength of sin *is* the law. **57** But thanks be to God, who gives **us** the victory through **our** Lord Jesus Christ.

**I go to prepare** a place for you. **3** And if **I** go and prepare a place for you, **I will come again** and **receive you to Myself**; that where **I am**, there you may be also.

**Philippians 3:20-21a**

For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also **eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, :21** who will **transform our vile body** that it may be conformed to His glorious body,

**1 Thessalonians 4:13-18**

But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. **:14** For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. **:15** For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. **:16** For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. **:17** Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds **to meet the Lord in the air. and thus we shall always be with the Lord. :18** Therefore comfort one another with these words.

**1 John 3:2-3**

Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. **3** And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.

The Imminent Appearing of Christ;  
ought to be a motivator for **Holiness**

**Romans 13:12**

The night is far spent, the day is at hand.  
Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness,

The Imminent Appearing of Christ;  
ought to be a motivator for **Preparedness**

**Titus 2:13-14**

Looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great **God** and **Savior** Jesus Christ, **14** who gave Himself for us, that He might **redeem** us from every lawless deed and **purify** for Himself His own **special people**, zealous for good works.

# The Imminent Appearing of Christ; ought to be a motivator for **Evangelism**

## **2 Corinthians 6:1-2**

We then, as workers together with Him also plead with you not to receive the grace of God in vain. **2**  
For He says: "In an acceptable time I have heard you, and in the day of salvation I have helped you."  
Behold,  
now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.

## **Matthew 24:44**

(for every generation of believers universally)  
Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming  
at an hour you do not expect.

Words or terms like; "Second Nature" or "Automatic"  
is exactly what is meant here. But listen to the warning.

Jesus is saying 'I am coming back for those who, yes, believe in Me but even more so, actually believe Me! When I said, 'Be watching and waiting' they took it seriously. When I do appear, they will be the ones who have been living life while expecting Me to walk through the door to greet them at any moment"

## **Luke 21:34-36**

"Be careful, because your hearts could be weighed down with dissipation, drunkenness and the anxieties of this life, and that day will close in on you unexpectedly like a trap. **:35** For it will come upon all those who live on the face of the whole earth. **:36** Be always on the watch, and pray that you may escape all that is about to happen, and that you may be able to stand before the Son of Man."

## **Revelation 3:10**

Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth.

## **1 Corinthians 15:51-52**

Behold, I tell you a mystery: **we** shall not all sleep, but **we** shall all be changed - **:52** in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. ## THE COMING OF THE KING

### 3.) The King's Second Coming

In a small way - yet in an extremely significant way, Jesus Christ rehearsed His actions of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming when He came to the temple and seeing all of the carnality and the commercialism, He, in His fury and indignation overturned the tables and carried in His hand, a whip of Cords and the words of judgment.

#### John 2:13-17

Now the Passover of the Jews was at hand, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. **14** And He found in the temple those who sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the money changers doing business. **15** When He had made a whip of cords, He drove them all out of the temple, with the sheep and the oxen, and poured out the changers' money and overturned the tables. **16** And He said to those who sold doves, "Take these things away! Do not make My Father's house a house of merchandise!" **17** Then His disciples remembered that it was written, "*Zeal for Your house has eaten Me up.*"

Remember at the beginning I gave you...

#### Malachi 3:1

"Behold, I send My messenger, and he will prepare the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple, even the Messenger of the covenant, in whom you delight. Behold, He is coming," Says the LORD of hosts (↓)

Verses 1 & 2 are separated by at least 2,000 years...

#### Malachi 3:2-5a

"But who can endure The Bay of His coming? And who can stand when He appears? For He is like a refiner's fire and like launderers' soap. **3** He will sit as a refiner and a purifier of silver; He will purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer to the LORD an offering in righteousness. **4** "Then the offering of Judah and Jerusalem will be pleasant to the LORD, as in the days of old, as in former years.

**5** And I will come near you for judgment;

Here is the exact same prophecy & insight  
from the prophet Isaiah.

### Isaiah 61:1-2(b)

“The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; **2** To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD ( ) and the day of **vengeance** of our God;

### Ezekiel 20:40-41

For on My holy mountain, on the mountain height of Israel,” says the Lord GOD, “there all the house of Israel, all of them in the land, shall serve Me; there I will accept them, and there I will require your offerings and the firstfruits of your sacrifices, together with all your holy things. **41** I will accept you as a sweet aroma when I bring you out from the peoples and gather you out of the countries where you have been scattered; and I will be hallowed in you before the Gentiles.

### Zachariah 8:3

“Thus says the LORD: ‘I will return to Zion, and dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. Jerusalem shall be called the City of Truth, the Mountain of the LORD of hosts, the Holy Mountain.’

### Jeremiah 30:18-20

“Thus says the LORD: ‘Behold, I will bring back the captivity of Jacob’s tents, and have mercy on his dwelling places; the city shall be built upon its own mound, and the palace shall remain according to its own plan. **19** Then out of them shall proceed thanksgiving and the voice of those who make merry; I will multiply them, and they shall not diminish; I will also glorify them, and they shall not be small. **20** Their children also shall be as before, and their congregation shall be established before Me; and I will punish all who oppress them.

### Matthew 24:26-33

“Therefore, if they say to you, ‘Look, He is in the desert!’ do not go out; or ‘Look, He is in the inner rooms!’ do not believe it. **27** For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. **28** For wherever the **carcass** is, there the **eagles** will be gathered together. **29** “Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. **30** Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. **31** And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other. **32** “Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. **33** So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near - at the doors!

The Biblical Overlay Does The Explaining for Us;

### Luke 17:30-37

Even so will it be in the day when the Son of Man is revealed. **31** “In that day, he who is on the housetop, and his goods are in the house, let him not come down to take them away. And likewise the one who is in the field, let him not turn back. **32** Remember Lot’s wife. **33** Whoever seeks to save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life will preserve it. **34** I tell you, in that night there will be two men in one bed: the one will be taken and the other will be left. **35** Two women will be grinding together: the one will be taken and the other left. **36** Two men will be in the field: the one will be taken and the other left.” **37** And they answered and said to Him, “Where, Lord?” So He said to them, “Wherever the **body** is, there the **eagles** ( aetos = unclean bird, vulture, griffin ) will be gathered together.”

## THE FOLLOWING DID NOT HAPPEN

**AT THE 1<sup>ST</sup> COMING. IT DOESN'T HAPPEN AT THE RAPTURE,**  
**IT CAN ONLY HAPPEN AT THE 2<sup>ND</sup> COMING**

### Revelation 19:1-21

After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, “Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God! **2** For true and righteous are His judgments, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her.” **3** Again they said, “Alleluia! Her smoke rises up forever and ever!” **4** And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who sat on the throne, saying, “Amen! Alleluia!” **5** Then a voice came from the throne, saying, “Praise our God, all you His servants and those who fear Him, both small and great!” **6** And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, “Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! **7** Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready.” **8** And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. **9** Then he said to me, “Write: ‘Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!’ ” And he said to me, “These are the true sayings of God.” **10** And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, “See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.” **11** Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. **12** His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. **13** He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. **14** And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. **15** Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God....

**16** And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written:

**KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.**

**17** Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, "Come and gather together for the supper of the great God, **18** that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great." **19** And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. **20** Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone. **21** And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse.

And all the birds were filled with their flesh.
